

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE SUN COUNTRY REGION VOLLEYBALL ASSOCIATION

MAR 26 1982

A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

Article 1
Name

The name of the corporation is The Sun Country Region Volleyball Association.

Article 2
Nonprofit Corporation

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

Article 3
Duration

The period of its duration is perpetual.

Article 4
Purposes

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (1) To foster national and international amateur volleyball competition;
- (2) To teach the sport of volleyball to children and adults by holding clinics conducted by qualified instructors in schools, playgrounds and parks;
- (3) To provide practice volleyball sessions, classroom lectures, seminars and panel discussions through which selected trainees may be schooled in competitive coaching, playing, officiating and scouting techniques;

- (4) To foster and conduct area, regional, state and national amateur volleyball competition;
- (5) To act as the official representative of the United States Volleyball Association within an area designated as Sun Country Region;
- (6) To select and train suitable candidates in the techniques of volleyball in national and international competition and thereby improve the caliber of candidates representing the United States in Olympic, Pan American and World Games competition;
- (7) To foster and conduct amateur volleyball programs between the United States and foreign nations for the exchange and training of suitable candidates in the techniques and practices of volleyball in countries other than their own.

Article 5
Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 4133 Hookheath, El Paso, Texas and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Frederick B. Buehler.

Article 6
Board of Directors

Article 8
Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 9
Additional Provisions

This organization shall work in cooperation with other volleyball associations which are also dedicated for the same general purposes.
