

## **SURVA Good Standing Policy Addendum**

**(7/15/2023)**

This addendum is provided for clarification of items identified in the SURVA Good Standing Policy.

The clarification will assist in determining each official's good standing status with SURVA.

Exceptions to this document will be considered case by case by the SURVA Assignor, SURVA Trainer and the Officials Representative. Note- If the good standing policy is changed or modified then this addendum may be revised to reflect the current changes outlined in SURVA Good Standing Policy for Volleyball officials.

Clarifications are identified below:

1. A Refcast form with selection of tournaments is due to the SURVA Assignor no later than the second Monday of December each season.
2. In addition to the Refcast, officials must register for each SURVA tournament in AES in order to be accepted by the SURVA Assignor.
3. Once an official registers in AES for a specific tournament, it will be considered by the SURVA Assignor that you are committed to that tournament.
4. All officials must complete all required training modules and the official's exam by January 31<sup>st</sup>
5. A request to be released from a tournament, which you have been accepted through AES, must be submitted via email AND approved by the SURVA Assignor. All requests must be submitted no later than four weeks prior to the tournament.
6. All Officials must work three preliminary tournaments with each being in separate months.
7. National level officials: In addition to the required three preliminary tournaments the official must commit to at least one bid tournament to fulfil your monthly activity.
8. Regional and provisional level officials: Monthly activity is defined as a minimum of 2 tournaments per month.
9. Officiating tournaments within the region, but not assigned by the SURVA Assignor, do not count as monthly activity.
10. Any official who is released from a tournament by the SURVA Assignor due to a low team entry, or an excessive number of officials signed up for the tournament may be asked to take the tournament off and a credit will still be given.
11. Officials are selected for all Championships utilizing the following criteria:
  - a. In full compliance with the good standing policy
  - b. Ranking i.e., National Level, Regional and provisional
  - c. High activity within the region will also be considered
